Increased Difficulty: Inner track, Rein-back, Plié on quarter-lines or centerline and with changes of bend, Medium trot to Plié combination, Flying Changes, Sections of medium and extended paces, Steeper diagonals of the half pass in trot and canter, Trot Half passes with change of bend, Medium canter to Counter-canter combination, Flying change to counter-canter, Counter canter on smaller curves, and Multiple coefficient moves. Up to four moves may be ridden one-handed.
